

The English Studio in London has two buildings — High Holborn and Catton Street. Both are minutes from the world-famous British Museum and Covent Garden Market.





STUDENT WELFARE

Our schools have nominated welfare and safeguarding team members on hand to support every student. We want to ensure students feel at home and comfortable as quickly as possible; that way they can make the most of their experience with us right from day one.

FREE CLUBS

Any student enrolled on a full-time course for adults* are invited to join our free clubs. They are a great way for students to supplement learning in class with practical skills needed in the real world and to build their confidence. Clubs are weekly, run for 1 hour and are entirely free.

Pronunciation Workshop - specific practice to fine-tune speaking, listening and conversation skills.

Current Affairs Conversation Club - we discuss the news, politics and economic viewpoints as students learn useful, everyday vocabulary and build confidence in discussing current affairs in English.

Interview Techniques and CV Writing Skills - ideal for students who want to impress recruiters and secure a job locally or in a global organisation.

Grammar Drop-in Workshop (Dublin only) - a little extra help outside of class focused on grammar. Designed to support students develop areas in which they are struggling and to ensure full understanding.






Most of Dublin's renowned sights can be walked to in less than half an hour, while the school is ideally located for transport links to travel further by bus or the Luas tram.





The English Studio values real-life communication and we use this as our guiding principle in delivering courses and lessons based on useful language relevant to the needs of our students. We emphasise that learning a language is about what students can do, rather than what they know.

The students at The English Studio really get the benefit from our dynamic teachers from the very beginning. Our classes are high energy and we give the learners plenty of opportunities to practise their speaking skills in the class. We offer continuous enrolment on our adult courses throughout the year in London and Dublin for students aged 16 and above.



PROGRESSION

Our adult courses are aligned to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR) and offer testing throughout to ensure student progression.



Electives

At The English Studio we offer Elective classes to help students achieve success outside of class. Electives have been designed to improve students' confidence and ability both in a social and a professional setting.

For 2020, our schools will offer the following electives to students on General, Intensive, Exam English and English for Business courses:

LONDON

Speaking

Our speaking classes aim to improve fluency of English and speed of delivery. Learning how to manage conversations, students will gain confidence to speak in a variety of formal and informal situations.

Project-Based English

The Project-Based English classes help students to develop a broad range of skills in English. These may include making a short film or radio programme, writing for a blog or school magazine, or organising a social programme.

Writing

Our writing elective will help students improve their effective and appropriate use of language in writing. Through practice, students will become more assured when writing in different formats and contexts.

Professional English

Ideal for those students who want to make improving their English for working in an international environment a priority during their course.

The electives offered may be dependent on the term and individual student's English level.

DUBLIN

Conversation

Our conversation classes will increase confidence and teach students how to manage conversations, as they practise speaking in a variety of formal and informal situations with their teacher and classmates.

IELTS Preparation (new for 2020)

The IELTS elective is a great option for students on our General English course who may wish to take the IELTS exam in the future and would like an introduction into the skills needed to succeed in the exam.

OET Preparation (new for 2020)

Designed specifically for healthcare professionals that would like to register to work and practise in an English-speaking environment, the OET elective will help prepare students to take the Occupational English Test.

Students will study a range of medical language and appropriate ways of communicating effectively with patients and their families.



General English

General English is always our most popular English course and is available for every level from complete beginner through to advanced.

And with our General English 20 option, students benefit from an additional 5 hours each week in our elective classes to further improve their fluency.

The accredited courses are suitable for students at any level. Students are placed in the correct class based on their placement test and regular progression testing.

Our teaching methods aim to develop communication skills, with an emphasis on speaking, pronunciation, grammar and listening. This approach is further reinforced

in our 20-hour course where students can enjoy one of our elective options.

This course is accredited by the British Council and ACELS ensuring high quality instruction from our supportive and passionate teaching staff.



Intensive English (London only)

Our Intensive English courses help students to communicate easily and confidently in English. Whether students are complete beginners, intermediate or even advanced, with either 25 or 30 hours of tuition per week, this is the recommended option to help them learn English more quickly.

Designed with our students' progress in mind, they will learn at the right level for their ability, with teacher support and regular progression testing throughout the course.

Students practise authentic English in a variety of ways including group work, pair work and individual work. Ideal for students whose time to study is limited or simply wanting to improve their English quickly.

On the Intensive English course, alongside General English language classes, students will study a selection of our elective classes dependent on their learning goals and English level.

The Intensive English courses are accredited by the British Council.



FAQs

When do payment of all course fees need to be made?

Full payment of all enrolment fees must be made prior to the course start date. Full payment is also required before the school is able to issue visa support paperwork for all non-EEA students.

What happens if a student's visa is refused?

Refunds in the case of visa refusals will be made upon receipt of relevant documentation and completion of the refund process detailed in section 5 of our terms and conditions. A 100 £/€ admin fee is applied to course cancellations due to visa refusals. Visa delivery (if applicable), enrolment and accommodation finding fees are non-refundable.

How do I check the visa requirements of students travelling to London or Dublin?

The UK and Irish government websites are a great resource; www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa and www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/Pages/check-irish-visa respectively. Courses from The English Studio in Dublin that are listed on The ILEP (The Interim List of Eligible Programmes) are appropriate for Stamp 2 Visa/academic year students.

How many students are in each class?

Maximum class sizes for London and Dublin vary. In London there is a maximum of 22 students per-class, average of 16. In Dublin there is a maximum of 15 students per-class, average of 12, due to restrictions enforced by the accrediting body, ACELS.

What social activities are provided free of charge?

We aim to provide as many free social activities as possible, starting with our local orientation walk! Further details of the social programmes can be found on pages 11 - 13.

When can students start their course?

We welcome students every Monday of the year with the exception of public holidays listed in section 11 of our terms and conditions. Our Dublin school operates 4 mid/end-of-course examination weeks, during which times we are unable to enrol short-term students.

What is the minimum age for adult courses?

16 years old. Please note that 16- and 17-year-old students enrolled on an adult course are unsupervised outside of lesson times, the school will need to be in receipt of a parental consent form and, for safeguarding reasons, students will need to be accommodated in half-board homestay provided by The English Studio and book a return transfer to/from homestay accommodation.

Are all course materials provided?

For adult courses, materials are payable separately. Students should do so prior to travelling however, course books can be purchased on arrival. Course books are a requirement for all courses.

FAQs

Are the schools accredited?

Yes, the London school is accredited by British Council and our Dublin school is accredited by ACELS. Both schools are proud members of industry bodies English UK (UK) and MEI (Ireland). Our CertTESOL course is accredited by Trinity College London.

When was the school founded?

The English Studio London was founded in 1997 in Shepherd's Bush, West London. Then joined with ECM Dublin (now The English Studio Dublin) in 2016. Interested to know more? Our full story can be found on the website.

Who should I talk to if I need support with my student's enrolment?

Prior to student arrival you can speak to your dedicated Business Development Manager. When the student is in-school you can talk to the local teams by contacting the main school telephone number.

When is the student placed in their class?

Students are placed in class after completion of the pre-arrival placement test in London and the placement interview on their first day in Dublin. Please ensure you share the student's email address when booking so we can send details of the placement test (for London) or their first day schedule (for Dublin).

When are the school holidays?

Both schools recognise national holidays in either the UK or Ireland. The schools share the same Christmas holiday (week-commencing 23/12/2019 and 21/12/2020). Further details of holidays can be found in section 11 of our terms and conditions.

Distances and timings

Any distances or timings referenced in this brochure are calculated using Google Maps (for both UK and Ireland). This includes travel times mentioned for both public transport and walking options.

Social programme - activity and excursion costs

Prices are quoted from July 2019 for activities and excursions. Some tickets are available to purchase at a discounted rate from The English Studio reception in London and Dublin. All other costs are quoted from the official website for the activity or excursion.

Transport costs

Any transport costs reference for travel on public transport are based on the price of pre-booked and off-peak travel costs for September 2019. The costs are quoted from trainline.com (for UK) and dublinpublictransport.ie (for Ireland). Flights and Eurostar prices are quoted from google.co.uk/flights for travel in September 2019.

Room options

All accommodation listed as en-suite has a private bathroom accessible only to residents of the room. All other accommodation options have access to a shared bathroom.

In our Studio accommodation in London, each en-suite room has a wet room, with a toilet, sink and shower.

Board (catering) options for Homestay accommodation

When booking Homestay accommodation, students can choose from self-catering, bed and breakfast or half board meal options. The meals included in each of these options are as follows:

- **Self-catering** - no meals included. Students will have access to use the kitchen in the homestay accommodation to prepare their own meals. They will need to purchase all of their food/meals. This option is only available in London.
- **Bed and breakfast** - breakfast is the only meal included. Students will have access to use the kitchen in the homestay accommodation to prepare their lunch and dinner. They will need to purchase their food/meals for lunch and dinner.
- **Half-board** - breakfast and dinner included. Students will have access to use the kitchen in the homestay accommodation to prepare their lunch. They will need to purchase their food/meals for lunch.
